

ANCHOR AWARDS JUDGES PACKET

The following forms and rules will be used for judging all the Anchor awards submitted

The awards to be judged are:

1. Ruby Newhall Anchor Service Award
2. Anchor Club of the Year
3. Do More Award
4. Care More Award
5. Be More Award

An Award Entry Form **MUST** be submitted for each award that the club is entering. If the Entry Form is not provided, the entry will be disqualified. All entries need to be postmarked no later than 30 days prior to the opening day of the Anchor Convention, where the winners will be announced. There will be two awards for the **Ruby Newhall Anchor Service Award** and two awards for the **Anchor Club of the Year**, based on size of membership (one award for 40 and less in membership and one award for 41 and above in membership). The **Do More, Care More and Be More** Awards will be awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards based on size of the membership, clubs with 40 members and less or 41 members and above. All entries must be **emailed** to the Awards Jury Chair, in accordance with the Anchor Awards Submission Details, found on the District website (www.pilotflorida.org, Anchors, Anchor Awards).

The Awards Jury Chair will prepare and send a Disqualification Form to the applicants were who disqualified, stating why.

The Awards Jury Chair will prepare and send a Non-Selection Letter to the clubs who did not receive an award for their submission, attaching a consolidated judging form, to assist them in the future.

The Awards Jury Chair will prepare and send a Judging Explanation Form, per award, with a consolidated judging form, to all clubs who submitted winning award packages so they know how they were judged and if they could improve for future years.

RUBY NEWHALL ANCHOR SERVICE AWARD

This award is given two Anchors, based on the size of the membership (one award for 40 and less in membership and one award for 41 and above in membership). It will be based on how active the Anchor was with their club from March 1 of the previous school year through January of the current school year, a written description of 300 words or less, by the nominee, describing how they served their community and letters of recommendation from **two** Pilots or Anchors who have direct knowledge of the services provided by the nominee.

ANCHOR CLUB OF THE YEAR

The District Anchor award uses the same criteria as Pilot International (PI) for the International Anchor Club of the Year. The District winner must follow the International criteria to be awarded as the International Club of the Year. This award is given two Anchor Clubs based on the size of membership (one award for 40 and less in membership and one award for 41 and above in membership). The application and judging form are located at www.anchorclubintl.org under Awards and Scholarships.

DO MORE AWARD

This award is for hands-on, direct service (examples – presenting programs or volunteering at veteran events, shelters, assisted living facilities, schools, hospitals, Special Olympics, support for caregivers). The established criteria for judging the award are on the Do More Judging Form. Each club can submit up to two award packages for two different service projects.

CARE MORE AWARD

This award is for advocacy or research service (examples – create a school program that discusses anti-bullying; hold a community information night, informing community members about the needs of senior citizens; take samples of community lake water to test for contamination). The established criteria for judging the award are on the Care More Judging Form.

BE MORE AWARD

This award is for a large impact on the community or school (examples – plan and organize a city-wide event; work with your school district to help make changes for the entire district; network with local businesses to create an event or show). The established criteria for judging the award are on the Be More Judging Form.

AWARDS JUDGED AT CONVENTION

CLUB POSTER AWARD (One entry per club/to be judged at Convention)

Each club may present one poster, to be carried and displayed at Convention, by a designated club member.

Poster should:

- Display the Convention Theme
- Display the Anchor Logo
- Display Anchor Club Name (or School's Name)
- Show Creativity

CLUB T-SHIRT AWARD (One entry per club/to be judged at Convention)

Each club will be asked to have one designated club member present the club t-shirt at Convention.

T-Shirt should:

- Display the Convention Theme
- Display the Anchor Logo
- Display Anchor Club Name (or School's Name)
- Show Creativity

LIP SYNC AWARDS (One entry per club/judged at Convention)

Lip syncs should be presented based upon the theme of convention and should be, between three to five minutes long, but no longer than five minutes. Clubs cannot use songs that have not been approved. See the Convention Packet for additional information and application.

SPIRIT AWARD (Judged at Convention)

Based upon how many members a club has, how many of them attend Convention, participation in the Poster Parade, Lip Sync and T-shirt contests. The District Anchor Officers will judge based on club involvement and sportsmanship while at Convention. Club involvement can be placing treats on the tables, presenting appropriate chants, participation in president's Anchor chant, etc.
